REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2018 AT 6:30 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Dalley calls the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE/INVOCATION:

Mayor Dalley led the pledge of allegiance. Councilmember Medina led the invocation. Moment of silence for the California fire victims. Moment of silence for the shooting victims at Jammerz.

Mayor Dalley recognizes Globe Councilmember Freddy Rios and Larry Alderman is present.

3. ROLL CALL OF COUNCIL MEMBERS:

PRESENT: Mayor Dalley, Vice Mayor Gonzales (arriving at 6:55 p.m.), Councilmember Black, Councilmember Bringhurst, Councilmember Castaneda, Councilmember Hanson and Councilmember Medina.

STAFF PRESENT: Town Manager Heatherly and Town Clerk Norris.
